

Camperly Seller Safety Checklist: How to Avoid Scams When Selling a Camper Online

1. Verify the Buyer's Identity

- Ask for the buyer's full name, city, and real phone number.
- Search the name and number online.
- Ask for a short video call if unsure.
- Avoid buyers who refuse calls or stay only in email or text.

2. Watch for Common Red Flags

- Poor grammar or generic messages.
- Buyer avoids answering questions about your camper.
- Requests for personal info early in the conversation.
- Urgency or pressure to act fast.
- Strange shipping or third party payment requests.
- Unfamiliar links especially for vehicle history reports.

3. Protect Your Personal Information

- Do not share your home address early.
- Share the camper VIN only after verifying the buyer.
- Never click buyer provided history report links.

- Never share banking details.

4. Beware of Fake Vehicle History Report Scams

- Do not pay for a vehicle history report from an unknown website.
- Purchase reports directly from reputable providers like Carfax, AutoCheck, or NMVTIS-approved sites.
- Never follow a link sent by the buyer for a report.
- Search the website online for reviews and scam warnings.
- Only provide proof after confirming buyer identity and verified payment.

5. Use Safe and Verified Payment Methods

- Use secure payment services.
- Camperly recommends KeySavvy escrow:

- Never accept overpayments.
- Avoid checks from unknown banks.

6. Verify Buyer Intent Before Meeting

- Ask what features they care about.

- Real buyers ask detailed questions.
- Require a phone call before meeting.
- Meet in public if possible.

7. Secure Safe In Person Interactions

- Bring someone with you.
- Keep keys until a valid driver license is shown.
- Never allow solo test drives.
- Leave if the situation feels wrong.

8. Use Technology and Security Tools

- Camperly uses encryption and anti bot systems for added safety.
- Stay alert because scammers can appear anywhere online.

9. Report Any Suspicious Activity
